




CANDLES & CAROLS

Thanks for Giving

We would like to thank everyone that contributed to the Hurricane Relief Fund. We raised **\$8,075** to help individuals and ministries who have been devastated by Hurricane Irma. **\$600** helped pay bills for individuals who lost their job at the City Pier Restaurant. **\$5,000** was donated to Echo Ministries to assist in hurricane recovery—cutting down trees and clearing debris so they can get back to their mission of reducing hunger and improving lives around the world. **\$6,000** was given from donations and existing mission funds to the Evangelical Seminary of Puerto Rico. While recovering from Hurricane Irma they suffered the direct onslaught of Hurricane Maria. TURKEY ROASTING SUGGESTIONS

Purchase an approximately 12 lb. turkey (if you wish reimbursement submit voucher with receipt to church office) Allow 3 to 3½ hours to roast, on Thanksgiving Day. Bring turkey and drippings to church between 12:00 & 1:00 PM.

ROAST TURKEY:

1. Pre-heat oven to 325 degrees.
2. Remove giblets & neck from inside turkey. Rinse bird with running cold water, drain well.
3. Place turkey, breast up, on rack in open roasting pan, sprinkle with salt and pepper. Do not cover.
4. When bird has browned as much as you wish, place over the breast, tent-fashion, a piece of heavy duty aluminum foil.
5. Roast until done.

TESTING FOR DONENESS: ONE OF TWO WAYS

1. Thermometer - insert in thickest part of meat, between breast and thigh, being careful tip doesn't touch bone, until it reads 185 degrees.
2. Hand method - leg should move easily when gently moved up and down.
